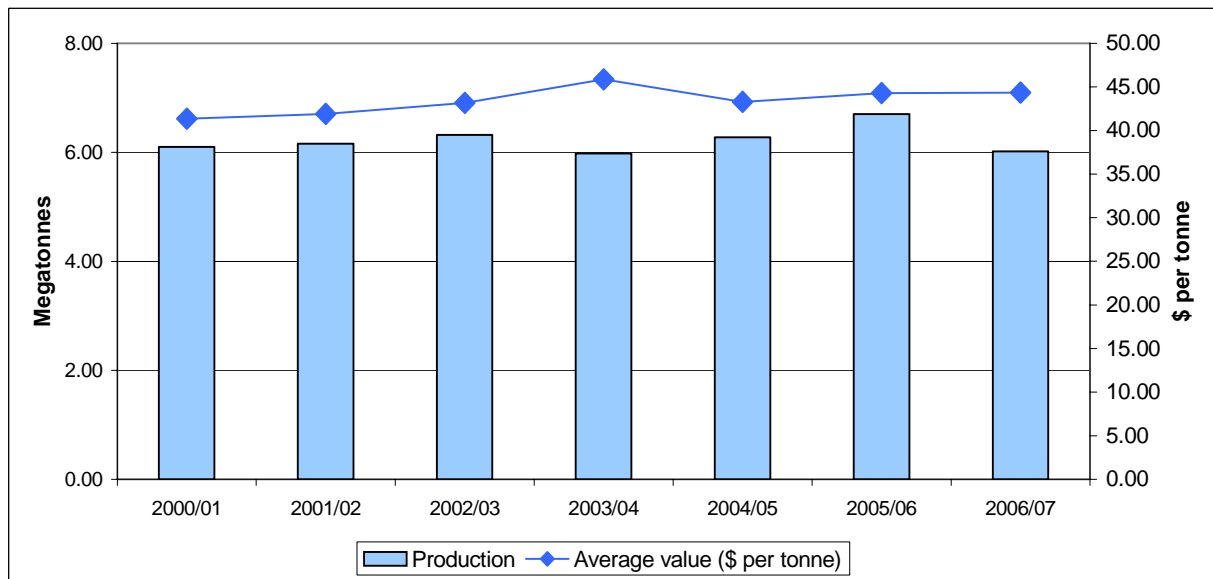

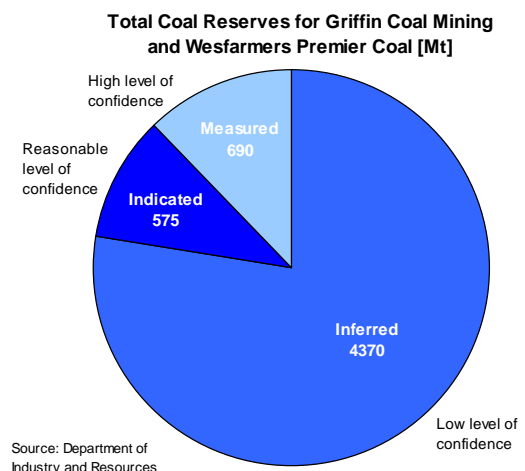
New Coal Developments
