Note that the tariffs with a number “1” or “3” apply to the South West Interconnected System, and the tariffs with a number “2” or “4” apply to regional Western Australia outside the South West Interconnected System. The Z tariff applies across all Western Australia.

The tariff rates are set to be the same in the South West Interconnected System and outside it, as per the [Uniform Tariff Policy](#).
